BCMC 2016 Opportunity Knox! Knoxville, TN

The 35<sup>th</sup> annual Building Component Manufacturer's Conference (BCMC) tradeshow was hosted in Knoxville, Tennessee on October 19–21 and saw a record number of attendees and exhibitors. Company attendance was up 10% and individual attendance up 4% from the previous year. The 34,000 ft<sup>2</sup> showroom floor was filled with 234 companies, 706 individuals and 111 exhibitors, all of whom were excited to either view or showcase new, innovative contributions to the component industry.

Although in past years, many attendees arrived to the conference early to volunteer in a home build with Operation Finally Home, this year the build did not take place. However, it is expected to return in Omaha, the site of the 2017 BCMC, where a recipient has already been chosen. Many attendees still arrived early to enjoy all that Knoxville has to offer.

Navy Captain George Dom kicked off the conference on Wednesday. After his presentation, educational sessions began. A ribbon-cutting ceremony at 10:15 a.m. signaled the opening of the showroom floor and attendees could begin browsing the exhibits.
